1. CLUB ATTENDANCE - Attend Board & Club Meetings Regularly (Include percentage of attendance.) Points awarded are equal to the percentage. (Possible Points: 100)
2. DIVISIONAL ATTENDANCE - Attend a divisional rally if any are held. Points awarded are equal to the percentage attended. (Possible Points: 100).
3. PCM ATTENDANCE - Attend Divisional President's Council Meetings. Percentage of PCMs attended is the equal to the points awarded. (Possible Points: 100)
4. DISTRICT ATTENDANCE - Attend Fall Rally & Spring Convention. Fifty Points are awarded for each event attended. (Possible Points: 100)
5. INTERNATIONAL PARTICIPATION - Attend the Key Club International Convention or a Key Leader Weekend for 50 points. Ensure that an article is submitted to the Keynoter for an additional 50 points. (Possible Points: 100)
6. OFFICER TRAINING CONFERENCE - Attend an officer training conference. Fall Rally is included in this. (Possible Points: 100)
7. MINN-KOTA KEY - Ensure that at least two articles are sent to the Minn-Kota Key. Award 50 points for each article submitted. (Possible Points: 100)
8. KIWANIS SPONSORSHIP - Ensure club participation with the sponsoring Kiwanis Club. In addition, the president should attend 5 Kiwanis club meetings. Award 50 points for serving with the Kiwanis Club. Award 10 points for every Kiwanis Club meeting attended until 50 points are given. (Possible Points: 100)
9. CLUB MEMBERSHIP - Sponsor at least two new students into membership. Each is worth 25 points. Ensure that club membership is stable or increasing, for which 50 points are awarded. (Possible Points: 100)

10. SERVICE - Complete at least 50 hours of service within the club (Possible Points: 100)

11. PROJECTS – Ten points are awarded for each project completed from the areas listed below. An additional 10 points will be awarded if the club incorporates the district theme into its projects.

13. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION – Provide evidence of work performed above and beyond the call of duty. Points are at the discretion of the judges. (Possible Points: 100)
